- Old scholar and now sporting hero Bruce Kamau played an important role in scoring the first goal for Adelaide United in the A-League Grand Final against West Sydney last Sunday.
- Year 9 student Anzac Lochowiak represented South Australia in the National Under 15 Kickstart Team at the AFL 2016 National Diversity Championships from April 3-8 at the Tony Ireland Stadium in Townsville. Throughout the 22 rounds of 20 minute footy games, Anzac kicked 8 goals and was named in the 2016 AFL's National Flying Boomerang Team (AFL's National Indigenous Program) to represent Australia. The Under 16 National NAB Championships against the World Team will be held at the Gold Coast in July.
