Our bowlers toiled manfully and it was pleasing to see **Cale Elefsen** in his debut 1st XI game bowl 7 economical overs.

In reply, the wickets fell regularly and aside from a partnership of 36 between **Harrison Rahaley** and **Dylan Fitzsimons**, we struggled to gain any momentum. **Scott Hammat**, also playing his first game, showed enough to suggest that he will be a solid contributor in the future.
